



ADURA TECHNOLOGIES CHOSEN FOR GOVERNMENT ENERGY EFFICIENCY PROGRAM

Adura Technologies today announced that it has been selected as an industrial partner in a \$6 million municipal and commercial energy efficiency program awarded by the California Energy Commission (CEC).

The CEC made the award to Oakland-based Energy Solutions for its Energy Technology Assistance Program (ETAP). Funds for the award come from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. The program is expected to begin in June.

ETAP will specify and implement advanced energy efficiency technologies, including those from Adura Technologies, in local government facilities state-wide. Adura's solutions will be applied to wireless lighting in buildings. The Adura LightPoint System™, the company's wireless platform, is designed to scale from a single device to an area, floor of a building or parking facility, several floors or an entire campus.

Adura may also help support ETAP's on-the-job energy auditing training. Kits previously developed and distributed by Adura will be used as part of the training.

"We see this as an opportunity to help the state and municipalities bring their costs under control with Adura management programs.
